## **Day 1 May 23, Tuesday: Depart USA**

Depart New York's JFK International Airport on Alitalia Airlines for our Pilgrimage to the Holy Land via Rome. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served aloft. (D,B,L)

## **Day 2 May 24, Wednesday: Arrive in the Land of the Bible**

Arrive at Ben Gurion Tel Aviv Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way Tour Manager will meet us upon our exit from Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus and soon, we will be on our way to the unforgettable Sea of Galilee for hotel check-in. **Celebrate Mass before dinner.** Dinner and overnight at hotel by the Sea of Galilee. (D)

## **Day 3 May 25, Thursday: Cana – Nazareth – Mt. Carmel**

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, begin our day with a visit to Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle. Visit the beautiful Franciscan Wedding Church, built in the nineteenth century over ruins from Jesus' time. See the display of stone jars and reflect on the miracle of the changing of water into wine. Continue on to Nazareth, the village in which Jesus grew up and lived most of his life. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of the Annunciation in Nazareth.** After Mass, visit St. Joseph's workshop and explore the magnificent Basilica of the Annunciation, Mary's Well, and the Church of the Old Synagogue, which marks the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. Independent lunch in Nazareth. After lunch, continue to Mt. Carmel (Vineyard of God) on the Mediterranean coast. Here the triumph of Elijah over the pagan prophets of Baal took place (1 Kings 18). Visit Stella Maris, the largest monastery of the Carmelite order, dedicated to the prophet Elijah and Mary, Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Time will be given for prayer at the Monastery. Dinner and overnight at hotel by the Sea of Galilee. (B,D)

## **Day 4 May 26, Friday: Upper Galilee/Caesarea Philippi – Around the Sea of Galilee**

Breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. The Gospels come to life as you imagine when Jesus walked on the water (John 6:19-21), calmed a storm (Matt. 8:23-26), and showed the disciples miraculous catches of fish (Luke 5:1-8; John 21:1-6). Arrive at the ancient city of Capernaum, where Jesus started His ministry and worked many miracles. Most Scripture scholars recognize the home of Peter's mother-in-law in the remains of a church near the shore as dedicated to his honor. At Tabgha, Jesus challenged His disciples to feed a crowd of 5,000 in the Multiplication of Loaves and Fishes. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Primacy.** Here, after the Resurrection, Jesus met with His disciples and told Peter to 'feed my lambs; feed my sheep'. Continue to the Mount of the Beatitudes, where Jesus offered His 'Sermon on the Mount.' Independent lunch. Drive north to explore the upper regions of Israel to the foot of Mount Hermon, overlooking Syria and the Road to Damascus, where Jesus appeared to Paul. Visit Caesarea Philippi and reflect in the place where Jesus looked at his disciples and said, "...But who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16:15). We will also renew our baptismal promises at Baniyas, the source of the Jordan River. Dinner and overnight at hotel by the Sea of Galilee. (B,D)

## **Day 5 May 27, Saturday: Mt. Tabor – Jordan Valley – Jericho – Jerusalem**

Breakfast at our hotel. Today's bus journey is filled with variety and excitement. Leave the Sea of Galilee and drive to Mt. Tabor. Transfer, by mini-van taxis, to the top of Mt. Tabor and enjoy a commanding view of all of Galilee. Visit the site of the Transfiguration, with time to reflect on Christ's humanity and Divinity, good preparation for the journey to Jerusalem. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Transfiguration.** Continue our journey along the Jordan Valley and marvel at the desert blooming with beautiful flowers, fruits and vegetables. Early afternoon arrive in Jericho, home of Joshua, Elijah's spring, Jesus' miracles and the Mt. of Temptation. Independent lunch in Jericho. Near the center of the city, a centuries-old sycamore tree reminds us of the incident in which the tax collector Zacchaeus climbed a sycamore tree in order to see Jesus. At dusk, we will arrive in Jerusalem. Check-in at hotel. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

## **Day 6 May 28, Sunday: Bethlehem – Mt. Olives, Mt. Zion and the Upper Room**

After breakfast, begin our day with a drive to the hills of Bethlehem. Visit the traditional birthplace of Jesus, in the Basilica of the Nativity. Venerate the silver star that marks the place where the sublime mystery of the Incarnation was revealed in a manger! Free time for independent lunch in Manger Square. This afternoon, drive to the top of Mount of Olives. The summit offers a magnificent view of the Old City. Visit the Chapel of the Ascension, the Shrine of Pater Noster and the Chapel of *Dominus Fleuit* (The Lord Wept). Then, follow Jesus' Palm Sunday route along Hosanna Road to the Garden of Gethsemane. Visit the Church of All Nations and pray at the "Rock of Agony," a section of bedrock believed to be the place where Jesus prayed alone in the garden on the night of His arrest. Continue to visit to the Church of St. Peter-in-Gallicantu, built on the site of the Palace of Caiaphas, the High Priest. Here, Jesus was imprisoned and Peter denied the Lord three times. Then we will visit Dormition Abbey, built to honor the Assumption of Our Lady. **Continue to the Upper Room, site of the Last Supper and descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles. Celebrate Mass in the Franciscan Chapel of the Cenacle.** Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

## **Day 7 May 29, Monday: Old City & Temple Mount – Ein Karem – New City**

After breakfast, explore the Old City and Temple Mount. Visit the excavation of the Western Wall (Ophel Hill). Walking through the narrow alleyways and streets of Jerusalem, see the Pinnacle of the Temple (*Gate of Hulda - after Pentecost, it was here where the disciples preached and baptized*). We will also see the newly constructed Jewish Quarter "Cardo." Visit the Crusader Church of St. Anne and explore the Pool of Bethesda. Independent lunch. Continue to Ein Karem, home of Elizabeth and Zachariah, and birthplace of John the Baptist. See the Church of the Visitation, with time for quiet meditation on the meeting between Mary and Elizabeth. Verses from the *Magnificat* are engraved on the columns of the church, and on the wall opposite it are ceramic tablets bearing verses from the *Magnificat* in forty two different languages. Continue to Yad Vashem for a visit to the Children's Pavilion and Avenue of the Righteous. End our day with a visit to the Israel Museum which houses the Dead Sea Scrolls. Next, explore an enlightening model of the city of Jerusalem as it was in the days of Jesus. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of the Visitation.** Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

## **Day 8 May 30, Tuesday: Via Dolorosa – Emmaus**

After breakfast drive to the Old City and enter through St. Stephen's Gate. Visit the Crusader Church of St. Anne and explore the Pool of Bethesda. Continue to the convent of the Sisters of Zion to see the Lithostrotos in the chapel of the Flagellation, where Jesus was tried and condemned by his crucifixion down the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. **Celebrate Mass at the Chapel of the Blessed Sacrament in the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre.** Independent lunch. Continue to one of the sites of Emmaus (*Abu Gosh*). We will recall the story in Luke's Gospel where Jesus appeared to His disciples on the road, after the Resurrection. Return to Jerusalem for group farewell dinner at the Ambassador hotel. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Jerusalem. (B,D)

## **Day 9 May 31, Wednesday: Tel Aviv – Continue to Rome**

After early breakfast, we will be transferred to Tel Aviv Airport for our flight to Rome, Italy. Arrive at Rome's Leonardo Da Vinci Airport, proceed through passport control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way tour manager will meet us upon our exit from Customs. Then, board our motor coach and soon we will be on our way to Rome and the "Eternal City". Check-in at hotel. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Rome. (B,D)

## **Day 10 June 1, Thursday: Catholic Charismatic Renewal Conference**

Breakfast at our hotel. **Catholic Charismatic Renewal Conference** schedule to be advised by Vatican. **Celebrate Mass** (*location to be advised*). Independent lunch. **Possible Tour Options: Vatican Museums; Sistine Chapel and St. Peter's Basilica.** Independent dinner. Overnight at hotel in Rome. (B)

## **Day 11 June 2, Friday: Catholic Charismatic Renewal Conference**

Breakfast at our hotel. **Catholic Charismatic Renewal Conference** schedule to be advised by Vatican. **Celebrate Mass** (*location to be advised*) **Possible Tour Options: Christian Rome (Major Basilicas – St. Paul Outside-the-Walls, Archbasilica of St. John Lateran, St. Mary Major)** Independent dinner. Overnight at hotel in Rome. (B)

## Day 12 June 3, Saturday: Catholic Charismatic Renewal Conference

Breakfast at our hotel. Catholic Charismatic Renewal Conference schedule to be advised by Vatican. **Celebrate Mass** (location to be advised).

**Possible Tour Options: Ancient Rome (Pantheon, Roman Forum, Piazza Navona, and Catacombs)** Independent dinner.

Overnight at hotel in Rome.

## Day 13 June 4, Pentecost Sunday: Papal Pentecost Mass – Festive Group Dinner

After early breakfast, we will be transported to St. Peter's Square for the 10:00 am Papal Mass celebrated by His Holiness Pope Francis. After Mass, remain for the noon Papal Blessing. Independent lunch with afternoon at leisure. Enjoy a farewell dinner at a restaurant in Rome. Experience an atmosphere of hospitality and friendship, and taste the Mediterranean cuisine in a typical Roman setting. Overnight at hotel in Rome.

We visit the Church of St. Anne, the Baptistery, Church of St. Maria degli Angeli, and the Convent of Padri Cappuccini. **Celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Maria degli Angeli.** Later afternoon, continue to San Giovanni Rotondo for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at hotel in San Giovanni Rotondo.

## Day 15 June 6, Tuesday: San Giovanni Rotondo

Early morning, **celebrate Mass at the Tomb of Saint (Padre) Pio.** After Mass, return to our hotel for breakfast. After breakfast, we return to visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Grace. Visit Padre Pio's cell. Independent lunch. Return to San Giovanni for devotional prayer and reflection.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in San Giovanni Rotondo.

## Day 16 June 7, Wednesday: Montecassino - Rome

Breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we leave San Giovanni Rotondo for Rome. En route, we will stop at Montecassino, to visit the 5th century Abbey of Montecassino, the cradle of the Benedictine Order founded by St. Benedict in 529. **Celebrate Mass at the Abbey.** After lunch, continue to Rome for hotel check-in. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Rome.

If you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare or other arrangements booked independently.

**DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES:** Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

**TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE:** Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

**ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS:** Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Matrimonial (full) bedded rooms are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple room accommodations because they are normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or matrimonial (full) bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. **Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of \$1,290 for the 14-Day Package, and additional \$295 for the Extension to San Giovanni Rotondo.** While single

rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be located away from the group. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

**MEALS:** Breakfast and dinner daily in the Holy Land. Breakfast daily and two (2) dinners for the basic Rome program; three (3) additional dinners on extension. Beverages (coffee, tea, mineral water) are not included at set menu dinners.

**GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES:** Gratuities to the tour manager, guides, and driver are not included in the package price. **\$80 will be added to each participant's final invoice to cover tips in the Holy Land; \$60 will be added for tips in Rome, and \$40 will be added to cover tips for the 3-Day Extension.** Tips for the tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour.
